“Oriental Style v.s. Western”

Judith started out with an Oriental Master, Shiou-Jang Hsieh, at the University of California Extension and studied with him for 12 years. After moving to Sonoma, she painted in a Western style for 5-6 years, but then returned to her love of the Chinese manner of painting.

Judith will bring examples of her Western watercolors to compare with her Chinese Brush paintings. Her lecture will conclude with a demonstration of the unique qualities of Chinese painting.

William F. Jackson (1850-1936) started his career, as a portrait painter but became Sacramento's premiere landscape artist during the late nineteenth and early twentieth centuries.

Grace Carpenter Hudson (1865-1937), though known as a portrait artist, painted numerous, but seldom-seen small landscapes. These personal outdoor sketches frequently inspired the backgrounds in her portraits.

Viewers will have a chance to consider how two Northern California artists chose to respond to the changes of their time in this dual exhibit.
