"Arbitrary Color"
(Acrylics & Oil)

Adele explains, "arbitrary color" means we choose our palette and arrange the colors in little flat planes, parallel to the canvas surface and not necessarily according to natural colors. We are not concerned with aerial or linear perspective and put together the shapes like a jig saw puzzle. (*Samples below include contemporary artists, left to right, Don Tiller, Royden Card and Ford Smith*)

The palette we'll use during the workshop is a primary triad (red,yellow,blue) composed of cadmium red light (Windsor Newton), cadmium yellow light and ultramarine blue plus white. We will all work on the same resource photo and paint along so that it's easier to grasp the concept. The time only allows for a basic introduction to this complex method. In Adele's ongoing classes, students subsequently work from a black and white photo and interpret the colors using various palette combinations.

Please bring your paints, brushes, odorless turpenoid, a small canvas or board (11" x 14") and something to cover your table and the carpet nearby. Although Adele will be painting in oil, this method works for acrylic painters as well.

Adele is a highly respected local artist and instructor. Her achievements are too numerous to mention in the space allowed and there are few of us in this area that haven't heard of her or seen her beautiful work.
