



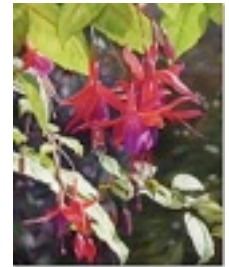

The Ukiah Valley Artists Co-op is writing to you to tell you about our Seventh Annual Art Faire on Saturday, June 6, 2015. The arts and craft fairs have been the most successful way for artists and crafts people to sell their work locally for the past several years!

This year, our Faire will be held at the Pear Tree Center in Ukiah. The block long area is along Perkins St., just off the 101 freeway, and is one of the busiest streets in Ukiah. There is abundant free parking directly behind the event in the huge parking lot!

We are informing you of this event because you are a respected and talented member of the art community and may wish to participate. If not, perhaps you know of someone else who would welcome this chance to show their work. The cost for an 11 ft. x 11ft. space is only \$50. This is a very modest fee for an all-day, annual event in a prime location!

This year the Faire is from 10am to 4 pm, no early closings will be permitted. Set-up starts at 8 am. Thanks to the location and layout of the spaces each vendor will be able to drive to their site for unloading but will need to be finished by 9:30. Each vendor will need to supply his or her own display equipment. In the event of rain, our back up date is June 13.

We encourage artists to join with friends and colleagues to book a space together. This makes it more affordable and you need fewer pieces of art per person.. The Faire is a great way to share your art with your community and spend some time with friends! Vendors may also book multiple spaces(limit 3 contiguous spaces)

Only original hand crafted items and paintings or reproductions by the displaying artist can be sold. First time vendors need to submit photos of their work, returning vendors are pre-approved

Send the enclosed form with your fee, if your application is declined your fee will be returned. Refunds will also be made on a case to case basis. .
